Please have your child say the name of the letter and then say the letter sound. Your child should place their finger on the dot under the sound and drag it to the right following the arrow while saying the sound. If there is just a dot under the letter, then the sound is a short sound and should be said quickly. The goal is for your child to identify the letter and its sound quickly with little to no pause. Lastly, have your child sound out the words at the bottom of the page first dragging out the sound of each letter while following the arrow and then saying it fast swiping their finger across the arrow quickly.
